**AMENDING ORDINANCE 25 OF THE CITY CODE
FIRE DEPARTMENT**

The City Council for the City of Waite Park, Minnesota, HEREBY ORDAINS that Ordinance 25 is hereby amended by revisions to Section 25.6, Eligibility, Appointments and Continued Service, of the Waite Park City Code as follows:

1. That Section 25.6, Subd. 1 Eligibility Subpart D is amended to read as follows:

“D. Reside in the City of Waite Park or to be able to respond to the fire station within nine (9) minutes from residence and place of employment.

D1. When staffing levels fall below 25 members, the Chief will have the discretion to waive and or modify the employment requirement of nine (9) minutes provided notice is given to the fire department officers and hiring committee. The applicant must also meet the following requirements.

- a. Must have NFPA 1001 training.
- b. Must have EMR or equivalent training.
- c. Must be able to attend drills, meetings, and truck checks.
- d. Applicant must be able to provide service during the response hours most needed.
- e. Attendance for drills, meetings, truck checks, and calls will be evaluated at 6 months after hire. If the applicant is not meeting the minimum requirements they shall be terminated.”
