Purpose: The City of Waite Park has been working on exploring the possibility of constructing an amphitheater in Waite Park. As part of this process, the City has been researching other amphitheaters in the Midwest that are of similar size to what is being proposed in Waite Park. The purpose of this mobile tour will be to tour the facility, discuss with key city officials and the management staff of the Amphitheater to learn from them on the design, layout, operation, and management of the site.
