

# RECYCLING GUIDELINES

## GLASS

Glass bottles and jars

Rinse, but labels may remain on glass



### NO:

- Dishes
- Drinking glasses or vases
- Window glass
- Light bulbs
- Broken Glass

## METALS

Aluminum and Tin cans

Rinse, but labels may remain on cans



### NO:

- Scrap metal
- Aerosol cans
- Paint cans

## CORRUGATED CARDBOARD

Only small amounts - Flatten and no larger than 36 inches square



## NO SHREDDED PAPER



**UPDATE:**  
Shredded paper needs to be bagged and placed in your garbage.

## PLASTIC

Containers with recycling codes 1-7

Remove caps and rinse container, but labels may remain on containers



### NO:

- Plastic bags
- Styrofoam
- Molded plastic
- Plastic without a recycling code

## PAPER

Newspapers and Inserts

Magazines

Catalogs

Phone books

Junk mail

Paper grocery bags

All envelopes

(Including window envelopes)

## BOXES

Paperboard boxes

Pop/beer cases

Cereal/Dry food boxes

Tissue boxes

Flatten all boxes



### NO:

- Wax coated boxes (ie. butter, frozen food boxes)
- Pizza Delivery Boxes
- Paper tissues
- Paper towels
- Paper plates
- Napkin
