

City Ordinance

Ordinance 91.12:

Removal of Animal Excrement.

Subd. 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to cause or permit an animal to be on any property, public or private, not owned or possessed by such person, unless such person has in his or her immediate possession a device for the removal of the excrement and a depository for the transmission of excrement to a proper receptacle located upon property owned or possessed by such person.

Subd. 2. It shall be unlawful for any person, owning or harboring an animal, to allow an unreasonable accumulation of animal excrement upon property owned or possessed by such person. An "unreasonable accumulation" is defined as an accumulation which omits an offensive odor which can be detected from adjacent property, which is unsightly or offensive to the sight or which creates a public health risk.

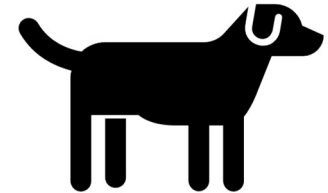

- Aesthetics



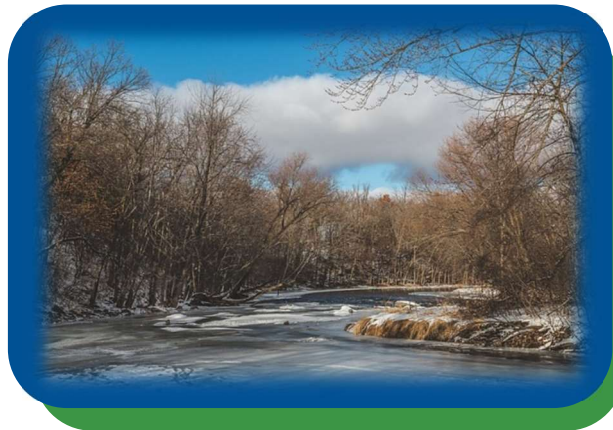
- Waterways

When it rains, pet waste can get washed away into our storm drains. The storm drains then drain directly into our local water ways.
